The Chair called the meeting to order at 2:00 PM.

Renewal of agreement for solid waste disposal

Kim Hallquist explained that the agreement is a renewal of the agreement the town has been using for several years to dispose of the towns solid waste at the Mount Carberry Landfill in Berlin, NH. The per ton cost has increased to \$58 per ton from the current \$48. She noted that there was no increase in the last renewal.

IT WAS MOVED (Nancy Rollins) AND SECONDED (Bill Helm) to approve the renewal of the agreement with the Androscoggin Valley Regional Refuse District for disposal of the town's solid waste at the Mount Carberry Landfill. THE MOTION WAS APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board noted that it would meet with the Recreation Commission on a more regular basis to ensure that the expectations of the Board for the Recreation Department are being met.
