Chair Rollins called the meeting to order at 2:00 PM.

**NONPUBLIC SESSION**

Kim Hallquist informed the Board that Joe Hogan, owner of the former Bewley property, called to ask if the Board would be interested in buying only the 7-acre lot on Newport Road across from Hannaford as he has a buyer for the two house lots behind the Gallery. Ms. Hallquist noted that she spoke with Chief Cobb who feels that either location would be suitable for a police station so she would have no objection.

The Board discussed that spending less than the \$600,000 asking price for all three lots would be preferable and the location would work as the site for a new police station. The Board directed Ms. Hallquist to contact Mr. Hogan to explore the price for purchasing the 7-acre lot on Newport Road.

The Board returned to the public session at 2:16PM.
