WHEREAS, Sandra A. Licks will leave the Tracy Memorial Library as its Library Director on February 12, 2021 to pursue new and exciting opportunities;

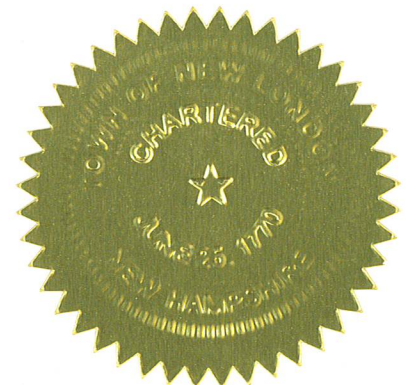
