

ANTIQUES – RSA 259:4 REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ Vehicle must be 25 years old
In its 26th year (In 2023, 1997 & older qualify)
- ✓ Antique vehicles or motorcycles maintained for use in exhibitions, club activities, & parades qualify for ANTI plates but there are no restrictions on use for this plate type.
- ✓ RSA 259:4 “maintained for use” shall mean a motor vehicle or motorcycle in its original condition or restored to original or better condition & not intended for daily use.
- ✓ First time registering will begin at Town Office & completed in Concord or Newport
- ✓ Town fee is based on list price.

ANTIQUES – TITLING

- ✓ A prior NH or Out of State title **OR**
- ✓ If title does not exist – the seller’s original or certified copy of the registration **OR**
- ✓ Notarized Affidavit of Ownership of an antique vehicle (TDMV 105) **AND**
- ✓ A Verification of Vehicle Identification (TDMV 19A) **AND**
- ✓ Bill of Sale, if sold within a year

If DMV finds a title in NMVTIS database that was not submitted, the request to title will not be honored without this title.

INSPECTION

Antique is any vehicle over 25 years old

- Antique Inspections due in April
- Annually: 40 years & younger
- Bi-Annually: 40 years & older
- All equipment on an antique motor vehicle shall be equivalent to or exceed the original manufacturer’s specifications
- Notwithstanding any other rule to the contrary, any motor vehicle with a model year 60 yrs. + shall be exempt from these rules as long as the motor vehicle is equipped as it was manufactured or in accordance with the motor vehicle’s original equipment specifications or exceeds manufacturer’s design intent.
