BOARD OF SELECTMEN NONPUBLIC MEETING MINUTES

June 9, 2022

The Board entered nonpublic session at 7:58 PM pursuant to RSA 91-A:3, II (d): “consideration of the acquisition, sale, or lease of real or personal property which, if discussed in public, would likely benefit a party or parties whose interests are adverse to those of the general community.”

Selectman Helm asked the Board if there was interest in considering acquiring the three Bewley lots, not just the one across from Hannaford that has been discussed as the police station site. He noted that he has learned that cemetery land may needed in the future and the addition land may work for those purposes. Chair Rollins noted that having the conversation made sense, observing that there are many answers needed prior to moving ahead.

The Board discussed the advisability of having a representative of the Board speak with Joe Hogan to ascertain whether the three lots would be sold to the town and if so, under what conditions. The Board agreed that Selectman Helm should contact Doug Lyon for this purpose.
