ALSO PRESENT:

Chair Casey called the meeting to order at 5:50 PM.

OLD BUSINESS

PLPA Bond Inclusion:

- The DRA required the inclusion of the PLPA bond in the budget.
- This is a bond that will be taken out, repaid, and eventually forgiven.
- It's a net-zero impact for tax purposes as it's reflected on both the expense and revenue sides.

Non-Lapsing Appropriation for Ephemera Archive Items:

- A non-lapsing appropriation for ephemera archive items had unexpectedly lapsed.
- The money remains in the account, and the request is to re-appropriate the \$3,000 to continue its use.

Conservation Commission Warrant Article (Timber Harvest):

- The Conservation Commission requested a warrant article for \$7,000 for timber harvest.
- This amount had to be included in the operating expense as it involves raising and appropriating funds, despite external funding sources.

Revenue Side Errors:

- Building Capital Reserve: Errors were identified in the building capital reserve, where the DPW project, cameras, and keypads were not initially excluded.
- Sewer Fund: There was a shortfall in the estimated revenue from sewer that needed to be corrected to offset revenue accurately.

IT WAS MOVED (Janet Kidder) **AND SECONDED** (Richard Anderson) to approve the new total for *capital outlay*, including the PLPA warrant article for \$100,000, bringing the total to \$911,033. **THE MOTION WAS APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY.**

IT WAS MOVED (Janet Kidder) **AND SECONDED** (Richard Anderson) to approve the transfer to capital reserves for the ephemera warrant article in the amount of \$3,000. **THE MOTION WAS APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY.**

IT WAS MOVED (Janet Kidder) **AND SECONDED** (Richard Anderson) to approve the new total budget amount of \$13,312,474. **THE MOTION WAS APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY.**

IT WAS MOVED (Janet Kidder) **AND SECONDED** (Richard Anderson) to approve the revenue total in the amount of \$4,936,607. **THE MOTION WAS APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY.**

IT WAS MOVED (Janet Kidder) **AND SECONDED** (Richard Anderson) **to adjourn. THE MOTION WAS APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY.**

The meeting adjourned at 5:55 PM.
