



Colby·Sawyer College

Factsheet

Founded in 1837, Colby-Sawyer College prepares students through a liberal education and pre-professional majors to make a difference in the world. Currently, the college offers 25 majors and 22 minors at the undergraduate level. The college also has an accelerated bachelor of nursing program, a master's of nursing program, a master's of business administration, and does workforce development through associate level programming for Dartmouth Health. Traditionally, the majority of the college's undergraduates hail from New England states. Each undergraduate student is required to complete an internship and a senior capstone project. Currently, the placement rate for students within six months of graduation for employment or graduate school is 98 percent. The college's endowment as of March 31, 2022 was \$62.8 million and the operating budget is \$35 million.

Panelist: Dr. Susan D. Stuebner joined Colby-Sawyer in July 2016. Prior to Colby-Sawyer, she held a number of administrative roles, most recently serving as executive vice president and chief operating officer at Allegheny College. Since her arrival, Stuebner has led and implemented a strategic planning process, achieved a record year for fundraising (FY2021), and has forged a partnership with Dartmouth Health focused on nursing and the health sciences. The college's endowment has nearly doubled during her tenure. Stuebner holds degrees from Dartmouth College (A.B. 1993) and Harvard University (Ed.M. 1998 and Ed.D. 2003).
