

**All** snowmobiles and OHRVs must be registered if operated off of the owner's property. A registration is a privilege to ride off your own property on approved trails or with written landowner permission. A registration is also required to operate on frozen lakes and ponds.

When registering an OHRV or snowmobile, the registrant:

1. Must be at least 18 years old & present a valid driver's license or non-driver photo ID. Registrations are issued to an individual;
2. Must present a valid NH driver's license or NH non-driver photo ID to qualify for resident rates;
3. Must provide the following vehicle information:
  - a. year of manufacture,
  - b. make, model, displacement,
  - c. primary and secondary colors,
  - d. VIN.

It is the responsibility of the registrant to ensure that the machine information is correct.

4. OHRVs & snowmobiles are not titled in NH, therefore, it is not required to have a title, bill of sale or previous registration;
5. Must present the appropriate proof of club membership to qualify for applicable member rate.
6. Will receive a printed registration certificate and two decals; and
7. Is responsible for verifying their registration information and affixing the decals appropriately.
