In order to register as a **new voter** you will need to bring two forms of ID to satisfy proof of identity, age and domicile.

1. To Vote. Completely fill in the oval  to the right of your choice. For each office vote for not more than the number of candidates stated in the sentence: "Vote for not more than \_\_\_\_". If you vote for more than the stated number of candidates, your vote for that office will not be counted.

2. To Vote by Write-In. To vote for a person whose name is not printed on the ballot, write in the name of the person in the "write-in" space. Completely fill in the oval  to the right of your choice.

**View online the Solar Panel production!**

When you go to the Highway Garage to cast your vote, take a look up at the roof, facing the street, where you'll see **210** new solar panels that began generating electricity on July 1, 2020. These panels not only produce enough electricity to power both Highway Garages - they also generate a surplus that offsets the electric use of some of our other town facilities.

Across the street at the end of Frothingham Road, another **428** solar panels came online May 19, 2020. They produce most of the electricity needed to run our six Sewer Pumping Stations. 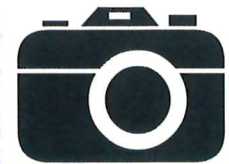
